



Exploring all around the beach







see at the sea today?*






Gert strolls through the soft, dry sand.







Without warning, clouds roll in,

Lightening flashes by.....oh my!






Gert is filled with fear as

Giggle




He does magic, tells some jokes,


Now Gert is feeling rather hot

***OOPS!***









Oh my goodness, a huge sea slug with **PURPLE** skin and eyes.


His diet must consist of **PURPLE** fries and **PURPLE** pies.
