

great **ANTICIPATION**.


She drags her conch shell to the sea


Gert is **HAPPY** for the gift.

She soars up into the sky....Whoosh!


Her eyes are huge with **SURPRISE**

while she is shaking all inside....oh my!




About this time, Pico Pelican flies by,

ANGRY — now her kite is trash.








When Pico sees what he has done,

I feel **SAD**. I’ve torn Gert’s kite.”






“Of course I will. Please bring it here.

and use my ink just like a glue.”






“That sounds a bit **DISGUSTING**, but I am sure that you know best. I can’t wait to take it back to Gert. It should pass the flying test!”




DRINK SEE GRUMS GINGER JUICE for upset tummies


“Wow! I am **GRATEFUL** to you, Pico!





